* Plymouth 10, Two Rivers 0 — More than half of the Panthers' 16 shots on goal found the back of the net in the blowout win at TR.

Logan Ryan registered a hat trick, and Zach Fohr and Franz Tadych each scored twice for Plymouth, which is now 12-0 in the Eastern Wisconsin Conference, 19-1 overall. The win clinches at least a share of the EWC championship.

Scott Koenig, Marcus Gamoke and Jack Heginbottom also scored.

TR (3-6-2) registered six shots on goal, the most against the Panthers all season. Jon Hintz stopped the shots for the shutout. Plymouth has now outscored its EWC opponents 105-2. Ben Schultz had three assists, Adam Bunke had two more and Brad Mallmann, Sam Zwick, Kody Babler and Gamoke had one apiece.

* Kiel 5, Campbellsport 0 — Brandon Riesterer scored four goals as the host Raiders improved to 14-6 overall, 9-3 in the EWC.

Bret Maurer also scored for Kiel, while Austin Lau and Jason Kuske each had two assists. Tyler Konz made two saves in goal for Kiel; TJ Mayer made eight for Campbellsport (4-14-1, 3-8-1).

* Sheboygan Falls 4, Waupun 0 — The Falcons kept their slim EWC title hopes alive with a shutout win at Waupun.

Karl Hubert registered a hat trick in the first half, and Nick Heitala added a goal in the second half for Falls, now 10-2 in the EWC with two games remaining on its schedule.

Ryan Halverson recorded a third straight shutout in the goal for Falls. Waupun dropped to 2-8-1 EWC.

* New Holstein 2, Kewaskum 2 (OT) — After a rough first half, the Huskies scored twice to salvage a tie.

Kain Roepke and Ambrose Lisowe scored goals for New Holstein (7-9-2, 5-5-2 EWC), with each player assisting on the other's goal. Ian Kenworthy scored twice for Kewaskum (0-10-2 EWC).
