A slow start was costly for the Huskies as they rallied to force overtime last Thursday at Kewaskum only to come away with a 2-2 tie.

Ian Kenworth's two first half goals staked the Indians to a 2-0 halftime lead before Kain Roepke scored three minutes into the second half, assisted by Ambrose Lisowe, to bring the Huskies to within one. Lisowe then took a feed from Roepke and tied the match at 2-all at the 52-minute mark.

"The second half and overtime were dominated by New Holstein, but it was not enough to win the game," said coach Nate Laabs in recapping the match.

"We continue to start the games poorly. We always battle back well in the second half, but we are always trying to play out of a hole."
