Kelly Steffen continued her fine cross country season finishing seventh overall as the New Holstein girls team placed seventh in the Campbellsport Invitational which took place last week Thursday on the Cougars' new course at Columbus Parc.

Steffen's time was 17:44. Kate Brooks of Winneconne was the individual champ at 16:23.

Carolyn Barth had one of her best efforts of the season coming 16th for the Huskies at 18:23.

Kendra Steffen was 31st in 19:43, Taylor Konkle 34th at 19:50, Jaime Langenfeld 47th in 20:54 and Sarah Winkler 55th at 21:59.

Winneconne won the team championship scoring 46 points, well ahead of runnerup Campbellsport's 83.

On the boys side, Mayville's Brian Roppel took charge from the start and won the 5k race in 17:05 but Manitowoc Lutheran had the better depth and took home team honors scoring 51 points with Winneconne second at 72. New Holstein was seventh.

A fraction of a second separated the Huskies' Jared and Kyle Schmitz. Jared was 29th at 21:17.11 with Kyle next at 21:17.59. Bill Jones was 36th at 21:57, Derek Schmitz 38th at 22:15 and Austin Dewhurst 43rd at 23:13.

The Huskies take part in the Eastern Wisconsin Conference Meet Saturday at UW-Sheboygan starting at 10 a.m.
