The Chilton/Valders/Brillion co-op team came in fourth.

The 200 freestyle relay team had the best finish for CVB taking third. Catherine Johnson, Allison Barnes, Katrien Rogers and Denys Koenigs finished in 1:58.65. Finishing fourth was the medley relay team of Johnson, Ashley Meyer, Koenigs and Andrea Berger in 2:13.77 with the 400 freestyle relay team also coming fourth at 4:36.41. Theresa Evenson, Allison Barnes, Molly Barnes and Berger make up that foursome.

Individually, Koenigs scored a fourth place finish in the 100 freestyle and was fifth in the 200 individual medley.

The 200 freestyle had Allison Barnes fifth and Evenson sixth. Berger added fifth place points in the 500 freestyle and Kora Mraz was sixth in the 100 backstroke.
