Chilton senior Denys Koenings and Valders' Andrea Berger led the way with two event wins.

Koenigs led a sweep of the first three places by C-V in the 200 individual medley winning at 2:41.67. Molly Barnes was second and Katrien Rogers third. Koenigs won the 100 butterfly in 1:13.52 with Molly Barnes taking second. Berger's victories came in the 50 freestyle (28.64 seconds) and the 500 freestyle (6:38.29).

Rogers led a 1-2-3 C-V sweep of the 100 yard freestyle winning at 1:07.37, just edging out teammate Theresa Evenson. Allison Barnes came in third place. Evenson won the 200 freestyle at 2:26.34 with Allison Barnes second.
