SHEBOYGAN FALLS - Windy conditions that made shots unpredictable at The Bull at Pine-hurst Farms made things tough for golfers Saturday at the She-

boygan County Invite.
Sheboygan Falls sophomore
Matt Bachmann pulled out a
field-best 78 to lead the Falcons to a first-place 339. Josh Smies finished three strokes behind in the individual standings and led Oostburg to a third-place team finish (373).

Sheboygan North picked up solid strokes up and down its lineup - Ellis Kirchenwitz led the team with an 87 - to finish second with a 363.

Strong wind gusts wreaked havoc early in the day, though, slowing play considerably and forcing golfers into some uncomfortable situations. fortable situations early in the season.

"Wind was a big factor," She-boygan Lutheran senior Nathan Hasenstein said after finishing his round. "You didn't really know where your shots were going before you hit them. You really had to factor that in on every shot pretty much, especially on drives with lower trajectory with the driver.

The Falcons are hoping to con-tend for another Eastern Wisconsin Conference title and a trip to State after Bachmann helped lead them to a fourth-place finish at the WIAA Division 2 State Championship meet. Matt Andrews is the only other golfer who joined the team in Madison last year.

"Expectations are to go back, repeat, head to State," Falcons coach Andrew Jagow said during

Saturday's meet. "We lost a few seniors but we have a lot of strong players in our sophomore class that I think can carry our team. Just looking to see some leadership and then some improvements in our younger guys and have a good season.

The team will likely compete with Plymouth's last season's EWC runner-up, and a Campbellsport squad that "gave us a good run last year," Jagow added. "Personally I think my goal in-dividually would be to win State,"

Bachmann said after finishing his round. "I think my game is to the point where it needs to be."

Sheboygan North pulled in strong score cards from its entirely scoring lineup. Behind Kirchenwitz's 87 were Brett Pokrzywisnki's 88, Lucas Scharrer's 91 and Christpher Lacey's 97.

And Oostburg, which finished in a tie for second place last season in the Central Lakeshore Conference, could leverage a strong roster with little turnover into a strong place again in the conference. Ray Kolocek scored a 90, Jerod TenPas carded a 98 and Joe
