

The Raider boys soccer team put a quick halt to their recent skid as they dominated Kewaskum in a 10-2 Eastern Wisconsin Conference win last Thursday on Kewaskum's new soccer facility.

"We had a lot of players get involved in our scoring. It was great to see," said Kiel coach John Adema.

Kiel built a commanding 6-0 halftime lead as Trevor Casper got things started scoring at the ten-minute mark off a pass from Jason Kuske. Bret Maurer and Trevor Rabe scored two first half goals each and Austin Lau added another. Matt Bonde and Jayson Kohlman had assists.

The onslaught continued in the second half.

Kuske scored at 43 and 54 minutes and another netfinder by Lau at the midway point made it 9-0 Kiel before the Indians finally got a shot past Kiel goalie Tyler Konz with Ian Kenworthy scoring with seven minutes left. Bonde scored the Raiders final goal with two minutes left and a Nick Gebhardt goal for Kewaskum with a minute left ended the scoring. Konz finished with ten saves as Kiel evened its EWC mark at 2-2.
