Buchholz took home gold in winning the 500 yard freestyle Saturday at the Plymouth Panther Invitational. Buchholz had a winning time of 5:25.57. She had previously placed third in the 200 freestyle posting a clocking at 2:05.79.

Kiley Van Lanen had a time of 28.59 seconds in the 50 yard freestyle placing her seventh. She added a tenth place effort in the 100 yard butterfly (1:11.72).

The 100 yard breaststroke saw Gabrielle Draxler place ninth at 1:28.17. Earlier in the day, Draxler also placed ninth in her first 11-dive competition of the season. She totaled 193.15 points.

In the 200 medley relay, Kiel's team of Buchholz, Draxler, VanLanen and Erin Barrette came in seventh place at 2:15.53, while the 400 freestyle relay team scored eighth place points. The team of VanLanen, Brooke Iserloth, Lauren Casper and Buchholz was clocked at 4:27.84.

Plymouth claimed the team title scoring 604 points with Sturgeon Bay second at 570.5. Kiel came in fifth at 161.
