Kiel put up a good fight but Campbellsport was able to take a three-game sweep of their Eastern Wisconsin Conference volleyball match last Thursday. The Cougars prevailed 25-23, 25-14 and 25-22. Brooke Goehring led the Raiders with six service aces and three block kills. Haley Rabe had a team-high 18 assists while Stacy Hartman put down seven spike kills and Sydney Walsdorf had eight digs. Kiel fell to 1-8 in the conference.

The Raiders also played in the Cedar Grove-Belgium Invitational as the defending champions and nearly won it again.

Green Bay NEW Lutheran defeated Kiel 25-14 and 25-22 before the Raiders rebounded with wins over Menasha St. Mary Central (27-25, 25-16) and Kohler (25-16, 25-16) to take second in pool play. The host Rockets then slipped by Kiel 28-26 and 25-22 in the semifinals.

Kiel also took part recently in the First Annual UW-Oshkosh Showcase Invitational, a two-day affair in the Kolf Sports Center at Oshkosh where the Raiders placed 15th out of 24 schools.

They sported a 2-5 overall record with both victories coming over Division 1 schools in Wisconsin Rapids (25-18, 25-17) and West Allis Central (25-21, 25-19). They fell to Oostburg, Oshkosh Lourdes, Kenosha St. Joseph, Antigo and Baraboo.

The Eastern Wisconsin Conference quad meet this Saturday in Waupun closes out conference play. Kiel will face Campbellsport, Two Rivers, Plymouth and Waupun.
