Little Chute and Valders were the top two teams and advance to this weekend's state meet in Wisconsin Rapids.

Kelly Steffen led the New Holstein girls. She came in 53rd at 17:41. Carolyn Barth was 76th at 18:41, followed next by Taylor Konkle (92nd, 19:49), Kendra Steffen (95th, 19:58), Sarah Winkler (100th, 20:08) and Raven Stevenson (104th, 21:31).

Chilton's Kristen Linzmeier was the individual champion at 15:07. Chilton and Luxemburg-Casco are the state team qualifiers.
