

The New Holstein volleyball team picked up a pair of home victories last week.

On Thursday, the Huskies bounced back from a 25-18 game one loss to win the next three and take a 3-1 victory from visiting Campbellsport 18-25, 25-13, 25-18 and 25-22.

Sara Steffen and Tara Zipperer led the attacking as Steffen put down 15 kills and Zipperer 14. Kari Meyers had 21 assists and Lexi Bullock 20 to set up those attacks. Kayla Meyer added seven kills as 27.42 percent of the Husky attacks went for kills.

Amelia Mirsberger led the defense digging out 18 Cougar spike attempts and had four serving aces on the night. Bullock led the team with five aces.

The win comes after a non-conference home victory over Mayville last Tuesday.

"This was a team effort," said coach Jon Weir.

"We got great play all around. Kayla Meyer, Sara Steffen, and Tara Zipperer all had strong attacking nights and Amelia Mirserger continues to be superb in the back row for us."
